

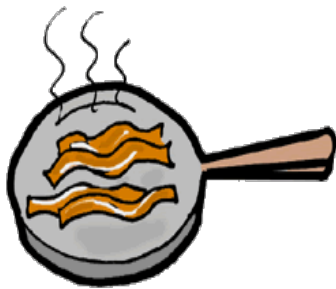

through Jesus Christ our Lord. Amen

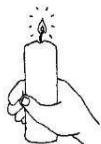


Reading: Psalm 1
